RE: Update and discussion regarding REAC inspections

SUMMARY:

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) mandates two types of inspections: those conducted by contractors hired by HUD's Real Estate Assessment Center (REAC) and others conducted by contractors hired by housing authorities. The latter are performed every year for every unit in a housing authority's portfolio, and are referred to as "UPCS inspections," as they follow HUD's Uniform Physical Standards Protocol.

REAC inspections, in contrast, target only 10 percent of a housing authority's portfolio. If a property scores above a 90 on a REAC inspection, the property is not inspected again for three years. If a property scores above 80, it is not inspected for two years. If a score is below 80, the property is inspected again the following year.

At the end of 2016, SAHA's average score was 90. In January 2017, HUD performed REAC inspections at 21 properties. The average score was 67. The scores ranged from 30 to 91. Some of the lower scores were appropriate, and staff is taking measures to address those shortcomings. Overall, however, the lower scores appear to be the result of new "quality of workmanship" standards introduced by HUD, a more stringent monitoring of 'inspectors' scoring, and, in some cases, because HUD performed a quality control assessment while the REAC inspector was inspecting SAHA's properties.

The deficiencies most often cited in this year's inspections were various problems with doors (e.g., damaged laminate, seals, or hardware), missing or inoperable smoke detectors, damaged refrigerator gaskets, dryer exhaust and issues with electrical outlets with ground fault circuit interrupters.

Later this year, SAHA expects HUD will perform REAC inspections at 59 properties.

The overall current average REAC score is 85.2.

RE: Update and discussion regarding ConnectHome

SUMMARY

Across the United States, only half of the lowest income families have internet connectivity in their homes, creating a digital divide that prevents children from using resources for their homework and other educational purposes. ConnectHome is a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) pilot initiative meant to accelerate broadband adoption by children and families living in HUD-assisted housing across the nation. There are 28 localities in the U.S. participating in ConnectHome.

The overall goal for the program is to bridge the digital divide. All ConnectHome efforts are based on three pillars of digital inclusion: Connectivity, Devices and Computer Training.

1. Connectivity

Build new models to provide broadband infrastructure and to offer residents free or discounted service.

2. Devices

Make broadband internet adoption sustainable by providing devices and technical support to residents.

3. Digital Literacy Training

Make broadband internet more valuable by giving residents localized, free and culturally sensitive training in essential digital literacy skills that will allow them to effectively utilize high-speed internet.

ConnectHome: San Antonio

Since the kick-off meeting in October 2015, ConnectHome has carried out initiatives at Springview, Cassiano, Alazan Apache, W.C. White, Villa Tranchese, Lincoln Heights and Charles Andrews. Training will be expanded to additional properties within the next year.

CONNECTIVITY

The ConnectHome connectivity goal is to provide a broadband connection in every HUD-assisted unit. Over the long term, Google Fiber has committed to providing free connectivity at many public housing communities in San Antonio. Meanwhile, through our ConnectHome efforts, SAHA has connected 323 units: 145 senior and disabled units and 178 multi-family units with school-aged children.

DEVICES

The ConnectHome device goal is to provide every resident with a free or low-cost computer. To that end, ConnectHome has partnered with Goodwill San Antonio to collect, refurbish and supply ConnectHome, at a very low cost, a monthly supply of 40 computers through at least March 2017. Google Goodware, Bexar County, Google Fiber, NowCast and SAHA employees have also donated a number of new and used computers to support this effort. SAHA has provided 332 devices to residents: 312 desktops/laptops and 11 Raspberry Pis. Additionally, 44 Kano Tablets were distributed to households with school-aged children.

DIGITAL LITERACY TRAINING

The ConnectHome goal for Digital Literacy Training is to ensure all residents receive useful and appropriate training in order to feel confident in engaging technology as a tool to support their education, employment and quality of life goals. Thus far, ConnectHome has trained over 703 participants, including training in partnership with Cafe College, Girls Inc., San Antonio Youth Code Jam, financial literacy partners and workforce development partners. 357 ConnectHome graduates have received computers and 178 hotspots.

ConnectHome is on track to fulfill its July 2017 goals:

- Provide ongoing computer training at 7 public housing sites
- Provide training to 360 participants
- Bring broadband connectivity to 384 households
- Provide 320 free computers to participants

SA Digital Inclusion Summit

ConnectHome, 80/20 Foundation, COSA and the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas at San Antonio joined forces to put together the first San Antonio Digital Inclusion Summit. This event brought together local and national organizations to discuss and highlight best practices to bridge the digital divide.

The Summit took place on March 1, 2017, at the San Antonio Central Public Library. There was a total of 166 attendees from across the country, presenting and discussing digital inclusion strategies.

Digital Inclusion Alliance

ConnectHome is part of a citywide Digital Inclusion Alliance initiative that includes the City of San Antonio, SAHA, Goodwill, School Districts, Google Fiber and many other organizations. The goal for the Alliance is to create a framework that fosters collaboration and the sharing of resources to provide services that help bridge the digital divide. The Digital Inclusion Alliance will be making use of a VISTA to help staff the organization as it grows.

RE: Update and discussion regarding Fiscal Year 2017 success stories

SUMMARY:

The Community Development Initiatives Department's work is largely focused on fulfilling SAHA's strategic goal No. 1: to empower and equip families to improve their quality of life and achieve economic stability. To accomplish this, staff works to provide services onsite and to offer opportunities to create a sense of place and community.

The CDI Department focuses on five major objectives:

- Improve quality of life for residents
- Provide access to resources and non-SAHA programs
- Improve resident capacity
- Facilitate residents to achieve self-sufficiency
- Improve agency performance

CDI continues to host community events and activities to keep hundreds of residents engaged. Furthermore, the department provides access to services to stabilize households and provide opportunities for residents to build capacity and achieve self-sufficiency. Some of the highlights of the first two quarters include:

- Over 1,271 Family Self-Sufficiency and Jobs Plus participants
- Over 150 FSS/Jobs Plus (average/quarter) participants enrolled into education and training
- 552 FSS/Jobs-Plus participants maintained employment

While the CDI Department is proud of the progress of the various metrics, it is important to note some of the success stories of our residents. Attached is a spreadsheet detailing many of the resident successes since July 1, 2016.
